For the past several years, Mr. Mill's has attended and participated in monthly Independent Special Districts of Orange County (ISDOC) Executive Committee meetings and quarterly events. In addition to serving on Serrano's board since 2016, Mr. Mill's has previously served 4 years on Villa Park City Council, including as Mayor and Mayor Pro Team, plus 3 years on OC Vector Control Board, and 2 years on OC Sanitation Board.
