NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a vacancy exists of the Board of Directors of the Upper San Luis Rey Resource Conservation District.

Please be advised that the Board of Directors will consider the appointment of a new director to fill the vacancy at a regular meeting of the Board scheduled for 4:00 p.m. on Thursday April 8, 2021, in the Yuima Municipal Water District Board room located at 34928 Valley Center Road, Pauma Valley, California.

Persons interested in being appointed must submit an application by letter to the Upper San Luis Rey Resource Conservation District, P.O. Box 921, Pauma Valley, California, 92061 no later than Friday, April 2, 2021.

Applications must state the applicant's qualifications and their reasons for wanting to serve on the board.

All applicants must be registered voters residing within the boundaries of Upper San Luis Rey Resource Conservation District and be prepared to serve as a director until November 2022.

Applicants must file a Fair Political Practices Act Disclosure Statement in accordance with the provisions of that Act and implementing regulations of the Fair Political Practices Commission. The Disclosure Statement must be filed at the District office prior to the appointment.

In accordance with Government Code section 1780(d)(1), this notice shall be posted in at least three conspicuous places within the Upper San Luis Rey Resource Conservation District.
