1. Consider Approval of the Upper San Luis Rey Resource Conservation District Fiscal Year 2024-25 Audited Financial Statements.

Background: As required by law, the District engaged the firm of Sonnenberg & Company CPAs to perform the Annual Independent Audit of the 2024-25 Financials. The Auditor found no issues of material concern and indicates that the financial statements have been fairly represented. This item is for the Boards review and acceptance of the Audited Financial Statements.

Recommendation: That the Board accept the Audited Financial Statements as presented.

2. Acceptance of the September 2025 Quarterly Report of the San Luis Rey RV Park Arroyo Toad Conservation Area. Lyall

Background: As required by the conservation easement, the quarterly report is presented for review and acceptance.

Recommendation: That, should the Board agree, they approve the report as presented.

3. Acceptance of the 2025 San Luis Rey RV Park Arroyo Toad Conservation Area Annual Report. Lyall

Background: The RCD of Greater SD is submitting a grant application today for projects that support the needs of the local NRCS office. Based on conversations with the Escondido Field office staff, Greater is seeking funding to perform the following:

Provide irrigation efficiency audits
Conduct soil sampling
Offer rangeland support
Organize annual local work group meetings

Recommendation: That, should the Board agree, they authorize the President to sign the completed contract once provided by Greater.

7. Ratification of Signing of Joint Letter in Support of AB 35: ABA Exemption from Prop 4 Funding Requirements. Lyall

Background: The District was asked to join in signing a joint letter in support of AB 35 which exempts certain agencies from having to adhere to strict and overburdensome reporting requirements in association with receiving Prop 4 funding. The President needed to respond by January 4; before the regular meeting of their RCD. The attached documentation explains the exemption and provides the sample letter that the President joined in signing. Staff is now asking the Board to ratify the support of AB 35 and joint letter signing.

Recommendation: That, should the Board agree, they ratify the support of AB 35 as presented.
